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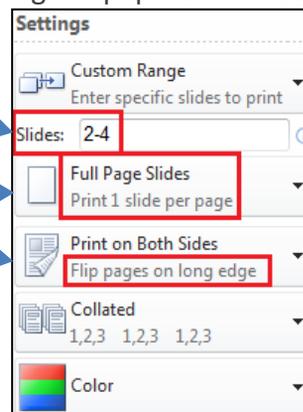
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## Printing Instructions; for the:

- **Recipe card**, print on cardstock using the double side print option. Pages 2 & 3 are designed to line up back and front when printed. The recipe card measures 3"x5".
- **Jar labels**, print on sticker back paper, cut to size.
- **Printer Settings:**

Here are my printer settings: Yours may be a little different depending on your printer, but the "options" should be similar. Practice on regular paper before cardstock to make sure its lines up properly.

- Print beginning on page 2
- Print 1 slide per page
- Print both sides, flipping pages on the long side



The cards are formatted and aligned to print properly on the back and front.

## Front Card A

### Dry Laundry Soap

**Prep Time:** 15 minutes

**Total Time:** 45 - 60 minutes

**Skill Level:** easy

**Yield:** 2 1/2 gallon

#### Supplies:

- 5 gallon bucket with lid (purchased from your local hardware store)
- 1 micro-planer
- Long handled wooden spoon (to reach the bottom of the 5 gallon bucket)
- 1 cup measuring cup
- 1 air tight container (holds 3-4 cups) to store soap for daily use
- 1 tablespoon measuring spoon to scoop into the washing machine

#### Ingredients:

- 1 box of Borax
- 2 boxes Arm and Hammer **Washing Soda** (not baking soda)
- 4-6 bars of Zote soap, Fels Naptha or Ivory Soap, grated



*Once you use the items for soap making, do not use them for cooking or food preparation. You can pick up some of these items at your local dollar store.*

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## Front Card B

### Liquid Laundry Soap (Concentrated)

**Prep Time:** 15 minutes

**Total Time:** 45 - 60 minutes

**Skill Level:** easy

**Yield:** 5 gallon drum

*Once you use the items for soap making, do not use them for cooking or food preparation.*

#### Supplies:

- 5 gallon bucket with lid (purchased from your local hardware store)
- Large 6 quart pan to melt soap on stove (purchased from Dollar Store)
- 1 micro-planer
- Long handled wooden spoon (to reach the bottom of the 5 gallon bucket)
- 1 cup measuring cup
- ½ cup measuring cup
- 1 tablespoon measuring spoon to scoop into the washing machine

#### Ingredients:

- 1 box of Borax
- 2 boxes Arm and Hammer **Washing Soda** (not baking soda)
- 4-6 bars of Zote soap, Fels Naptha or Ivory Soap, grated
- Few drops of your favorite essential oils



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## Back Card A

### Instructions:

1. Freeze the Zote soap prior to grating. This soap is soft and will get soft with the heat of your hands. Grate the soap using the micro planner.
2. In large 5 gallon bucket, add Borax, Washing Soda and grated soap.
3. Mix well.
4. Use 1-2 tablespoons per load.

*Safe to use in front loaders*

**For a smaller laundry soap recipe use:** 1 cup Borax, 1 cup Washing Soda, 1 bar grated Zote. Store soap in an air tight container. Use 1 – 2 tablespoon per load. Regularly soiled clothing only requires 1 tbsp.

*This recipe will do 5-6 loads of laundry a week for 6 months.*

## Back Card B

### Instructions:

1. Using a micro-planer, grate the Zote soap directly into a large 6 quart pan.
2. Place pan on stove top and add enough water to fill the 6 qt pan  $\frac{3}{4}$  full.
3. Boil until grated soap is dissolved. Once dissolved, pour liquid into bucket.
4. Slowly, add Arm and Hammer washing soda and Borax to the bucket.  
*(Do not add the liquid to the powder, the powder will waft in the air)*
5. Stir until dissolved, add enough warm water to fill the 5 gallon bucket.
6. Put the lid on and keep in a cold dark place for 24 hours. The liquid laundry soap will turn into a thick gel. Stir a couple of times over the course of the next day or so.

*Always stir the gel before using.*

7. In a separate air tight container, for daily use, add the concentrated liquid soap mixture to fill the container half-way.
8. Add enough warm water to fill the container and shake.  
*Note: Always shake or stir before using.*
9. Use the same amount of the liquid soap you would with store-bought laundry soap.
