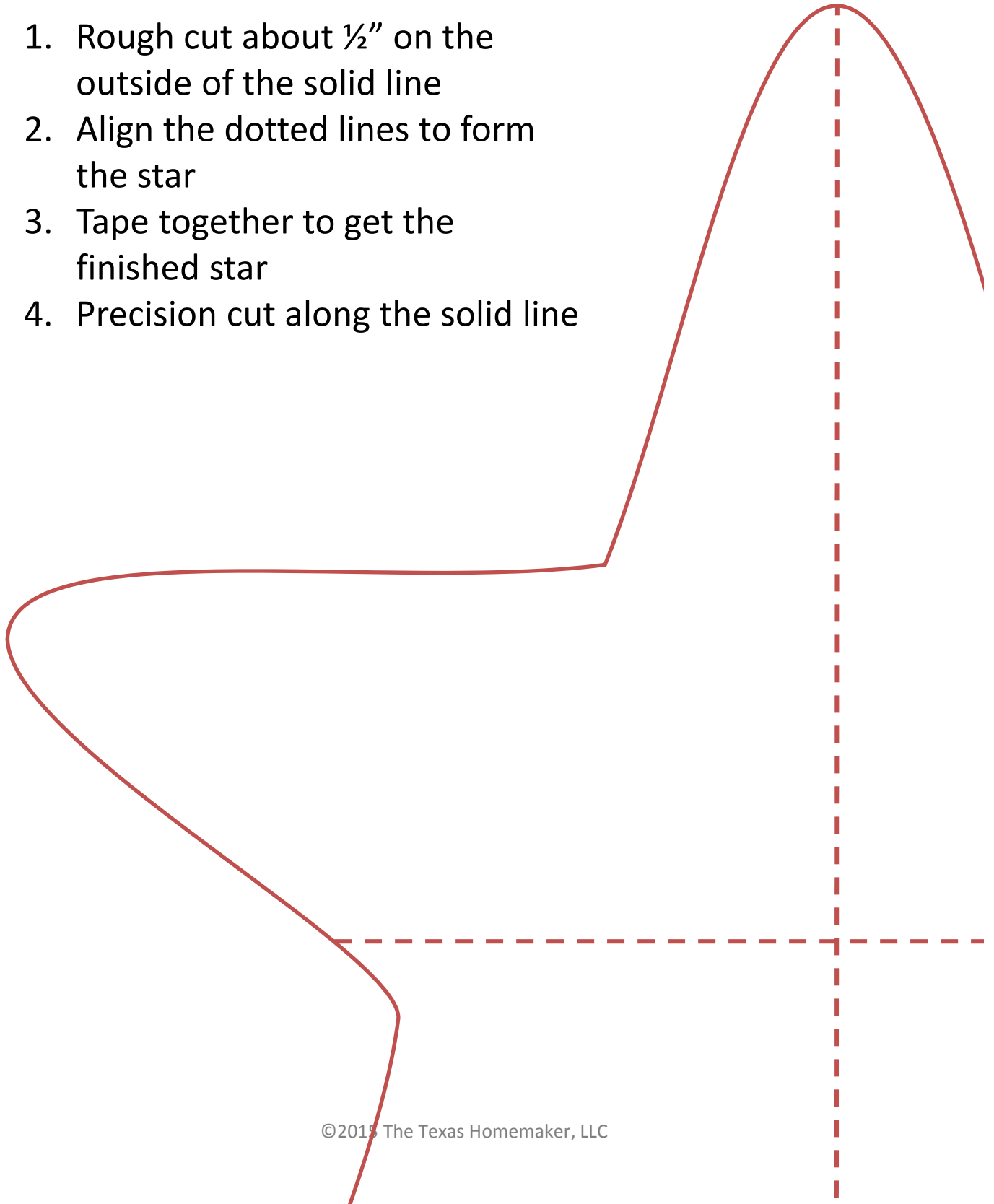

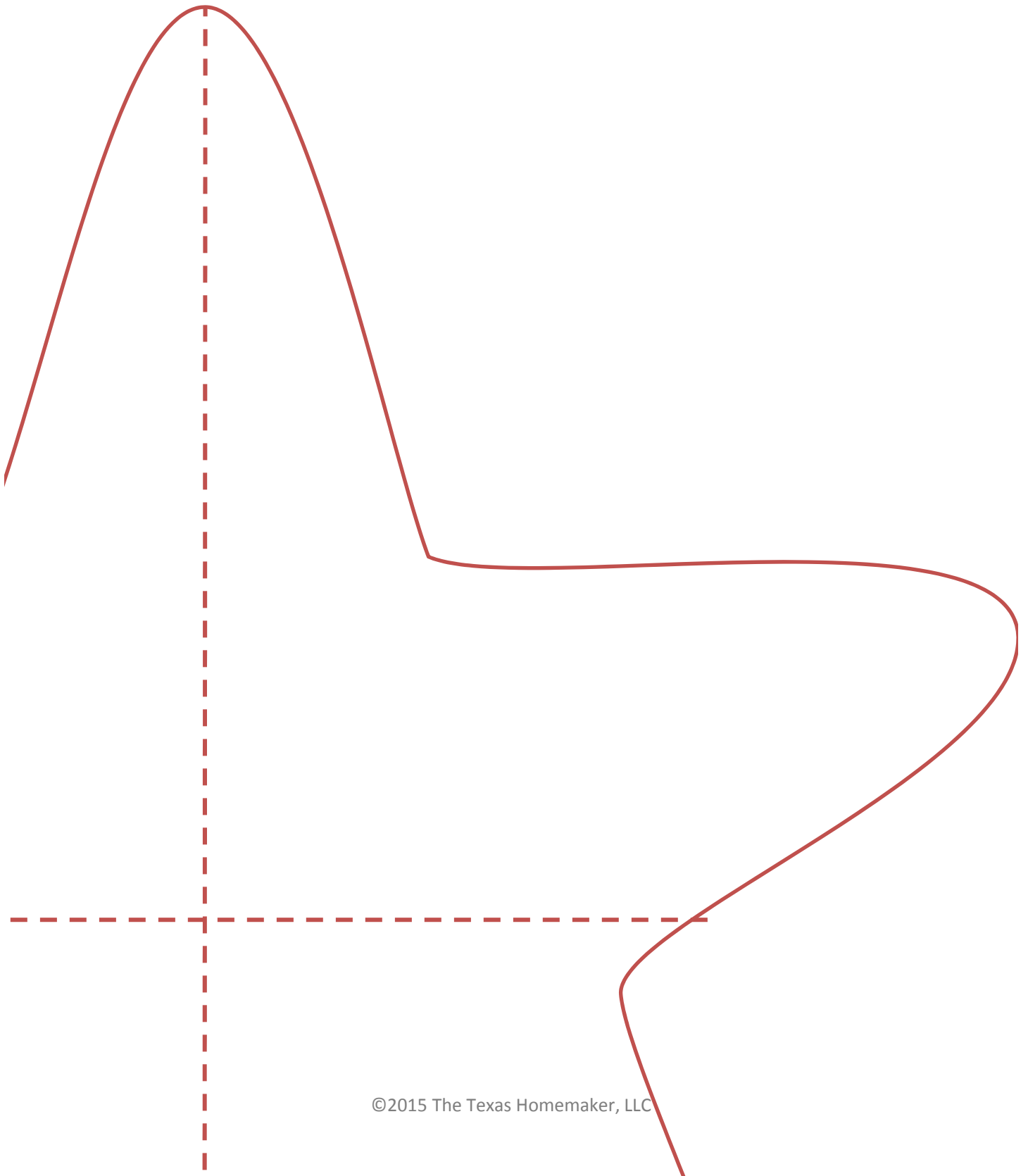
- **Printables:** print on cardstock

# Large Star – Top Left

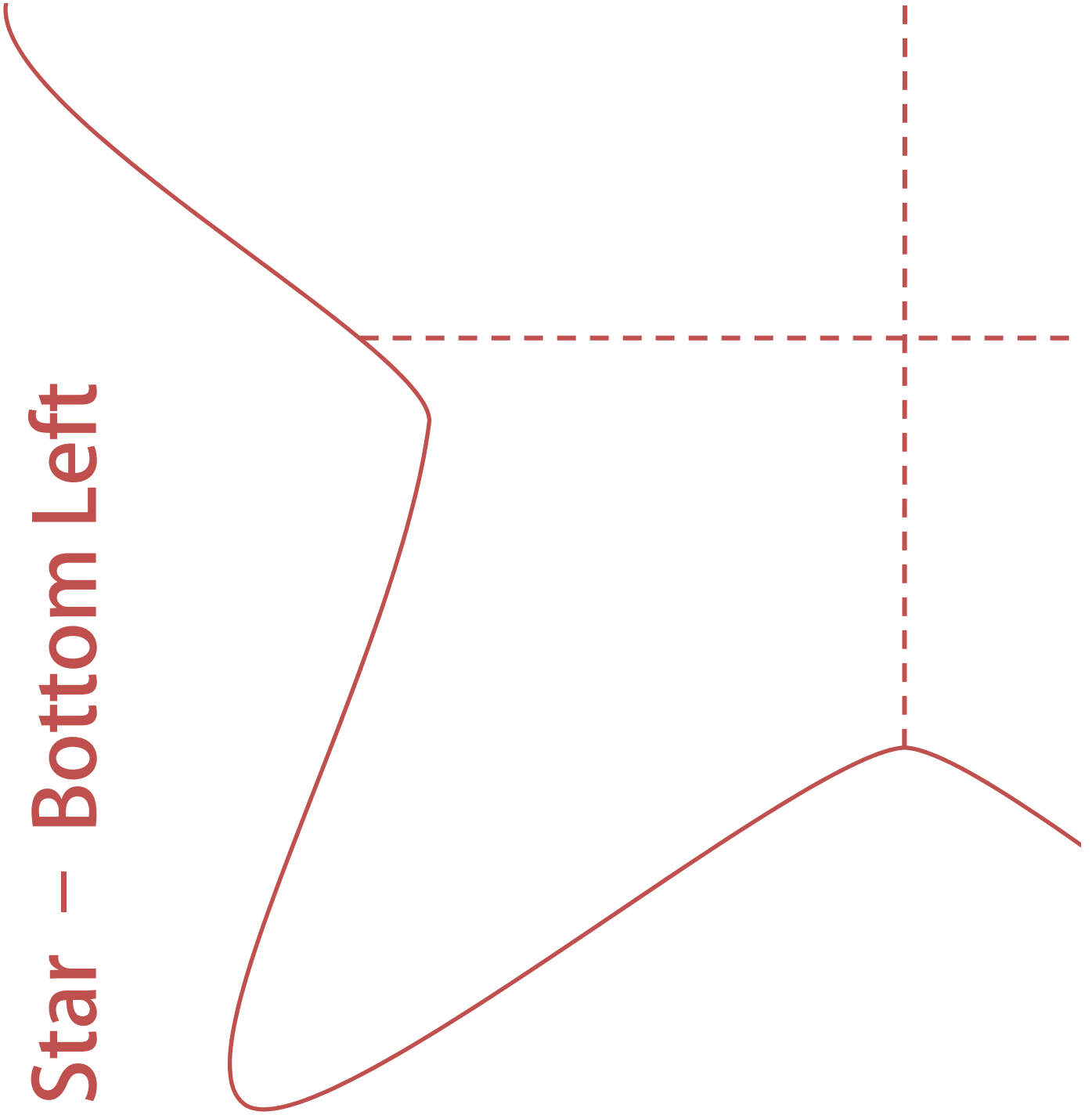
1. Rough cut about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " on the outside of the solid line

4. Precision cut along the solid line



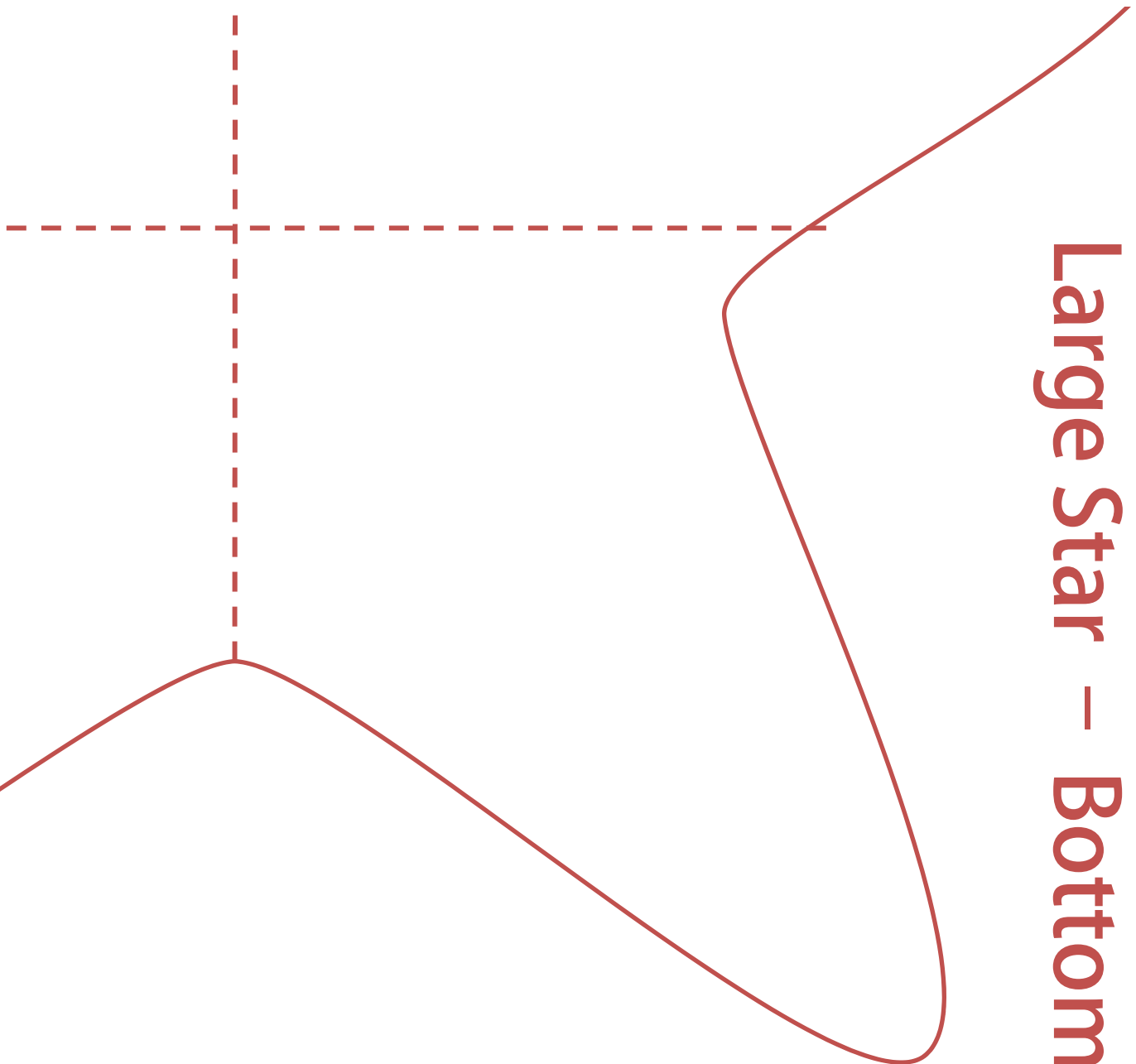
# Large Star – Top Right



# Large Star – Bottom Left

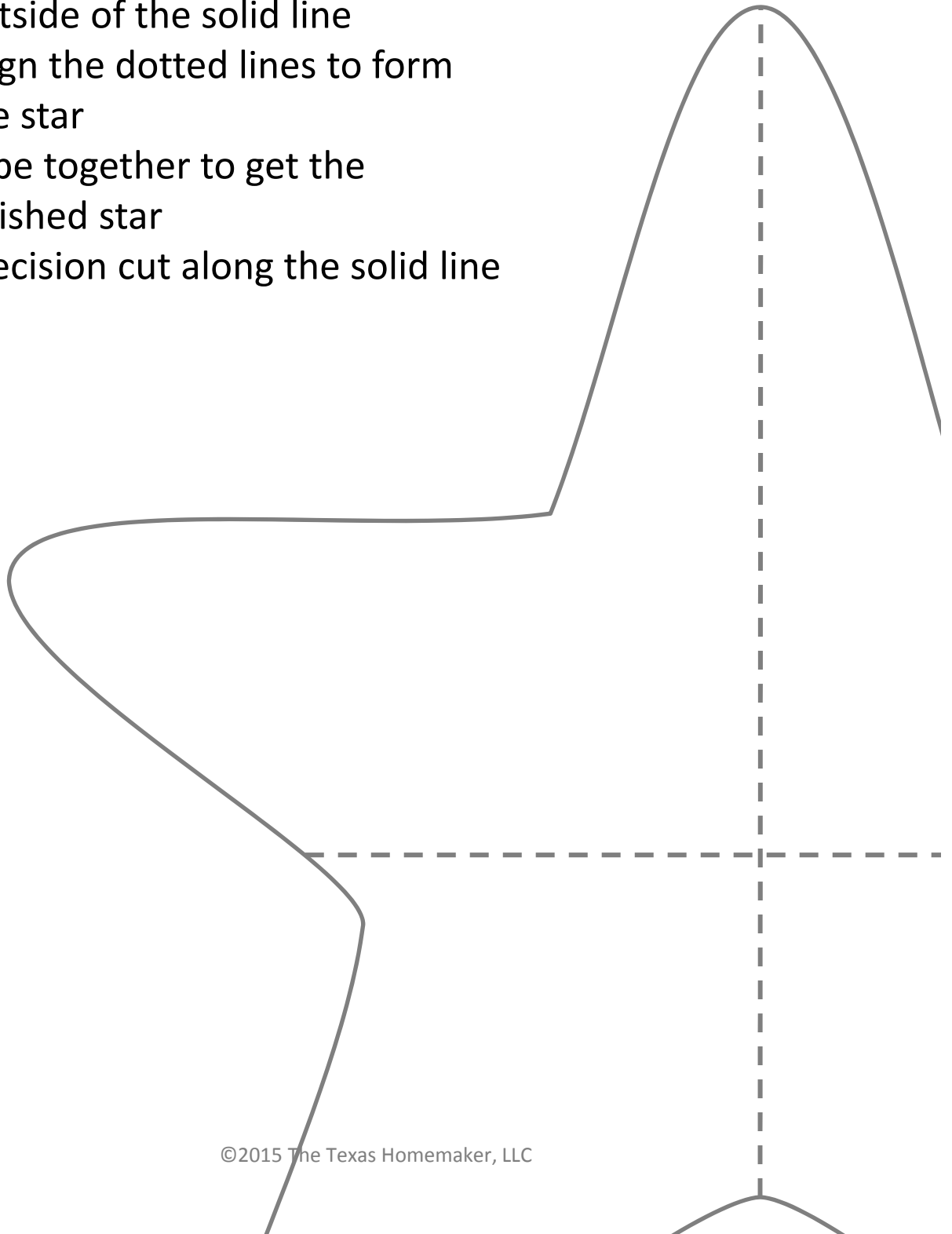


# Large Star – Bottom Right

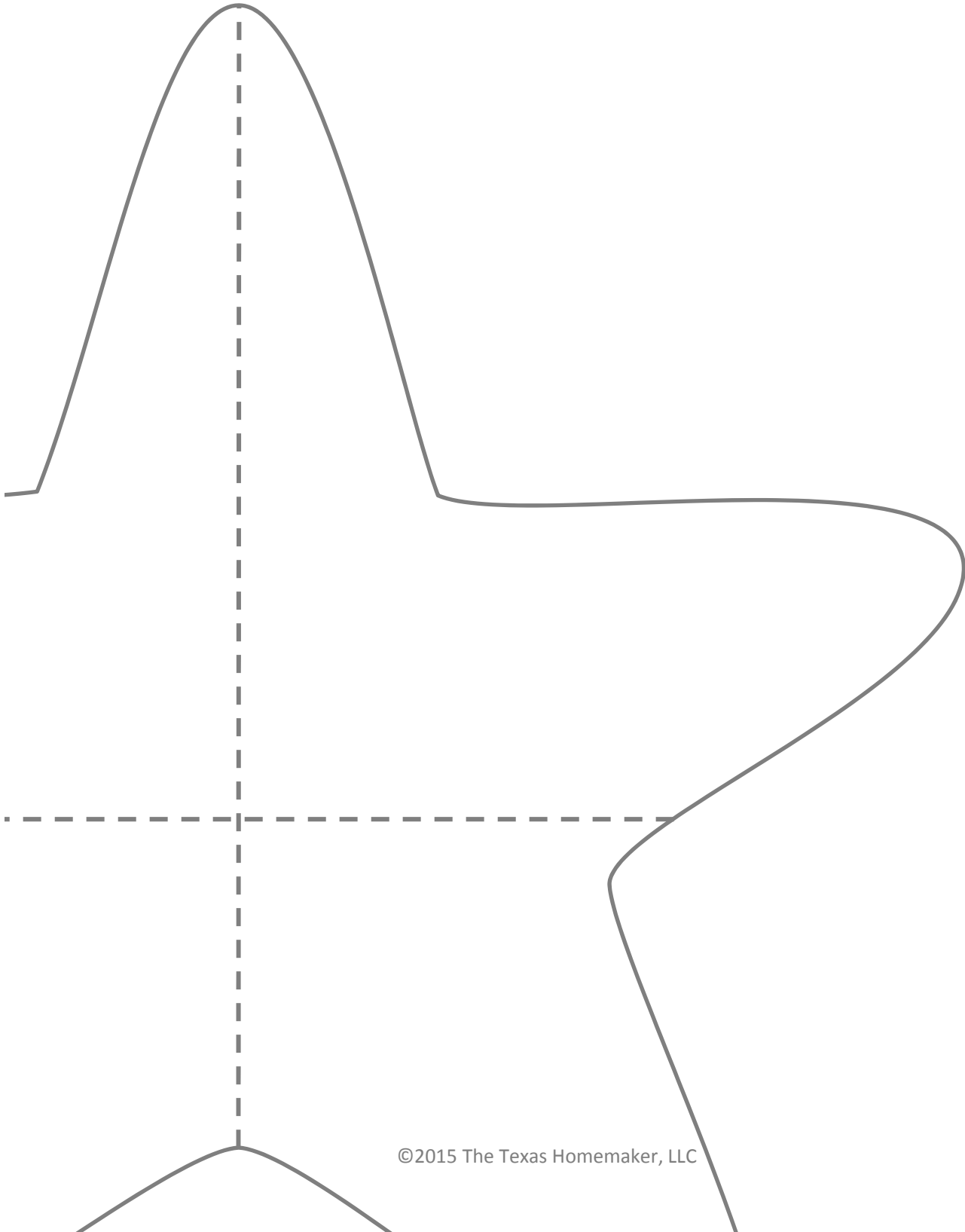


# Medium Star – Top Left

4. Precision cut along the solid line

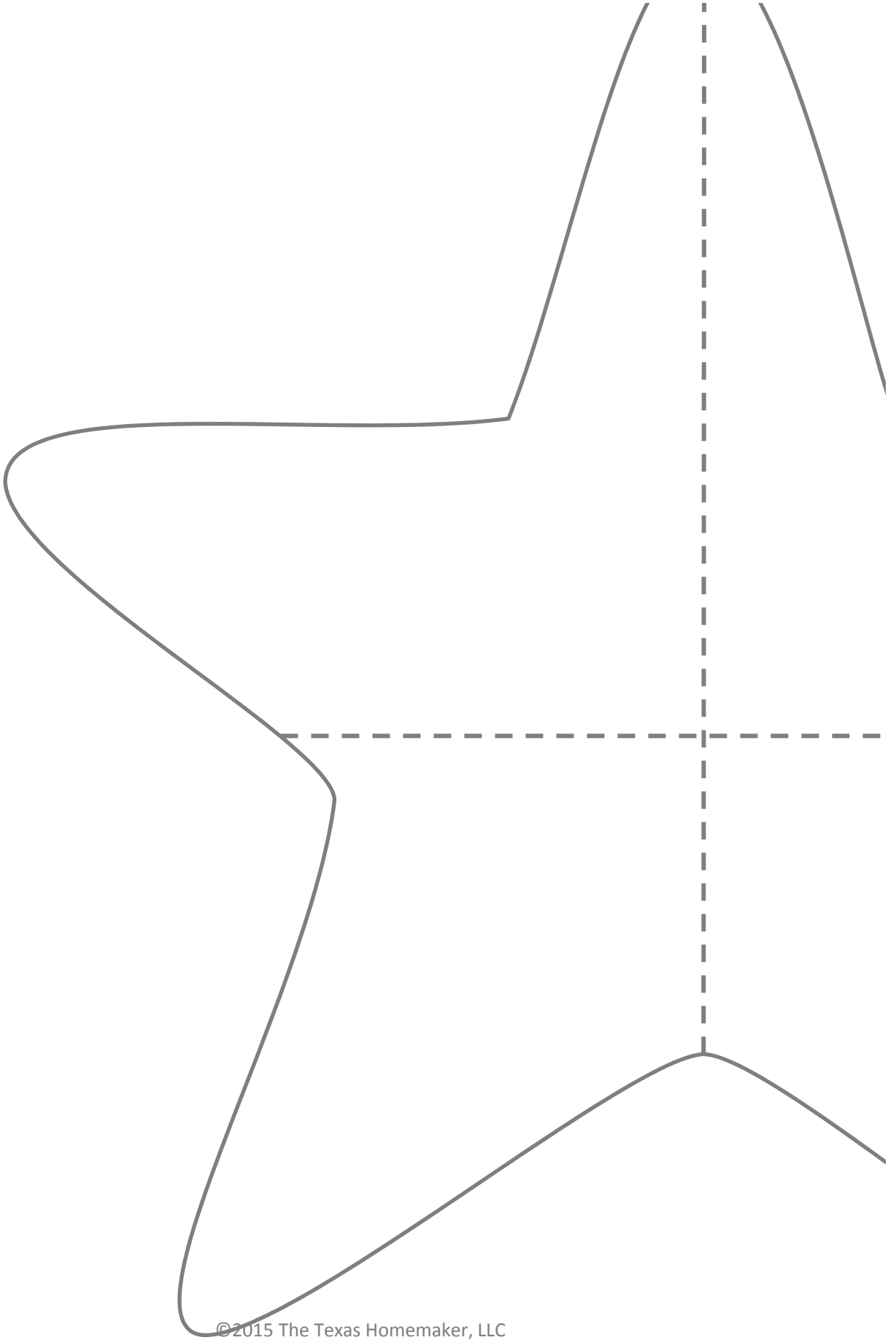


# Medium Star – Top Right

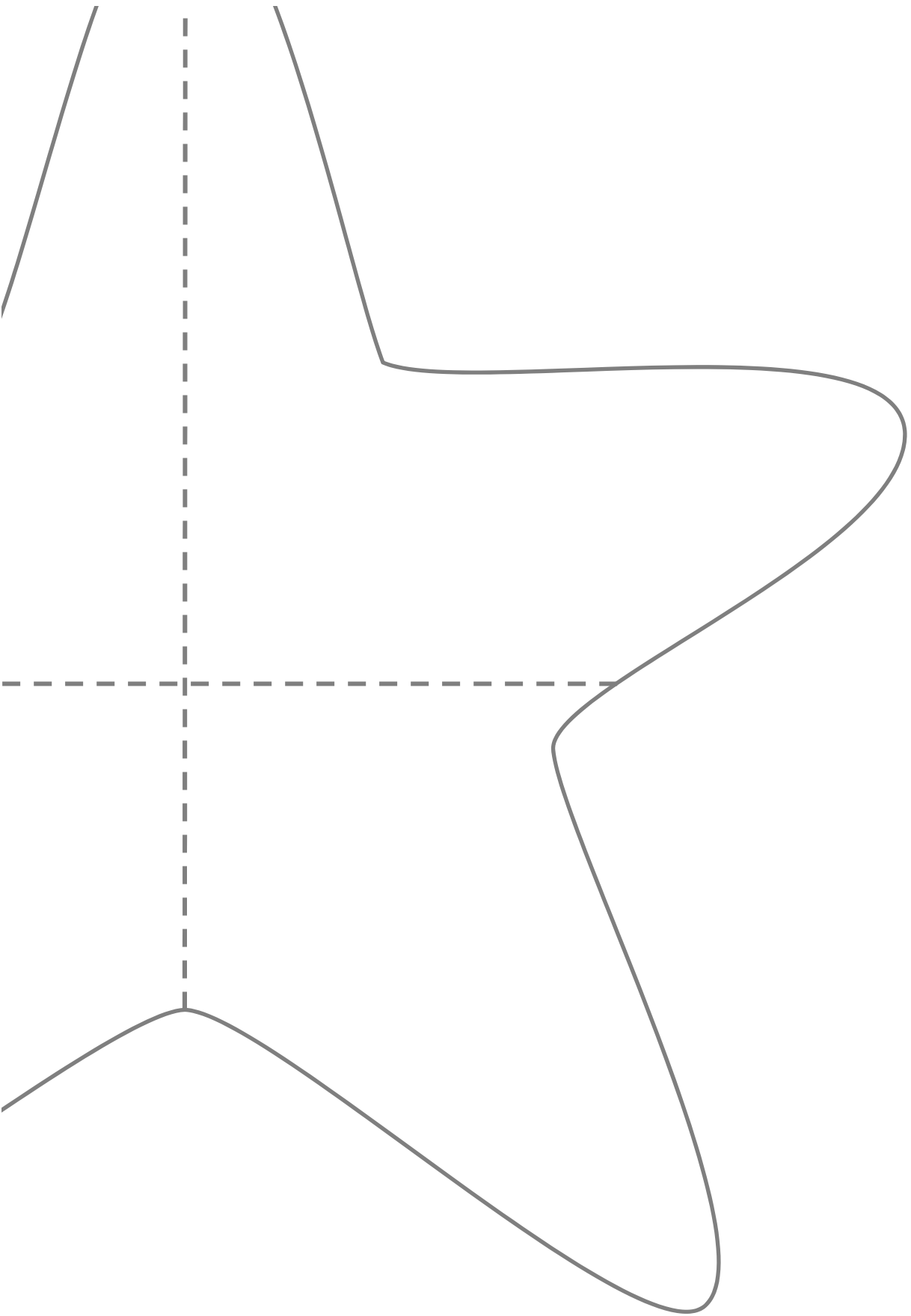




# Medium Star – Bottom Left

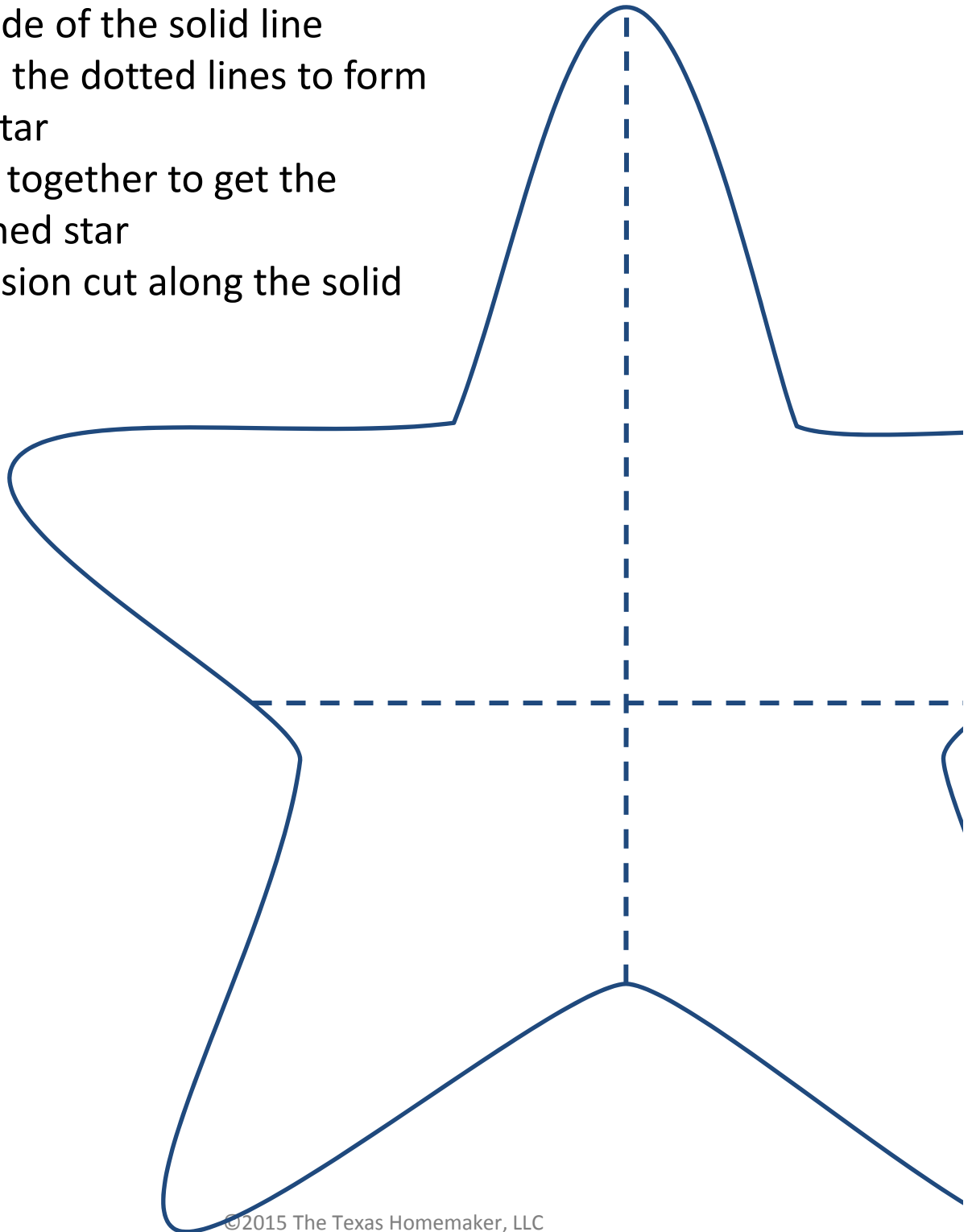


# Medium Star – Bottom Right
